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REGULATIONS

ART. 1

On the initiative of the "Le Cheval de Trait Ardennais" Royal Society, hereinafter called "the Committee", the 74th Exhibition of Agricultural, Horticultural, Forestry and Civil Engineering Equipment, including the "Agricultural Extension" section, as well as the "food products" section and a comprehensive programme of animal breeding competitions and horse shows, will be held in Libramont on 25 - 26 - 27 and 28 July 2008.

ART. 2

The exhibition will be inaugurated and officially opened by members of the Committee on Friday, 25 July at 10.00 a.m. It will be made more prestigious by the presence of numerous Belgian and foreign personalities.

ART. 3

FAIRGROUND PITCHES AND HIRE CHARGES (25 - 26 - 27 and 28 July 2008)

3.1. Outside pitches

A. Agricultural, forestry and civil engineering equipment, horticultural equipment and agricultural products – See form 1A

Pitches covering an area of 150m² and less: €10.40/m²

Pitches covering an area of 151m² to 400m²: €9.40/m²

Pitches covering an area of 401m² to 500m²: €8.40/m²

Pitches with several floors: surcharge of 50 %

Pitches bordering on a ring: surcharge of €1/m²

Each fraction of a square metre will be charged as one square metre.

Pitches covering an area of more than 500 m²: €7.40/m²

Surcharge for corner location: €120.00 per corner.

Minimum hire charge: €374,40

B. Belgian food products ("Ardenne Joyeuse") See Form 1C

€200 per 10 m² module.

3.2. Covered pitches

A. Non-commercial organisations of general interest and in the area of education, engineering and consultancy firms - See Form IB

Walexpo – mezzanine – stand fully equipped: €50/m²

Walexpo – ground floor – stand fully equipped: category A = stand in the centre of Walexpo: €261/m² - category

B = stand under mezzanine, personalised and well finished: €209/m² - category C = stand under mezzanine, basic and modular: €141.60 /m²

B. 1) Livestock hall – animals, genetics: €38.00/m² unequipped stand

2) Animal health hall: €38.00/m² unequipped stand

C. "Market Hall" - Non-agricultural products

Covered pitches (unequipped stand, no partitions) - Libramont Market Hall: €49.00/m²

Uniform depth of 3 m, with units of 4 m of frontage.

Except for pitches around the outside: 5 m of frontage - 2 or 5 m deep. Corner location: €120.00 per corner.

Minimum hire charge: €490.00

An area will be set aside where agri-foodstuffs firms will be given priority

3.3 Hire charges

A discount of 10% of the price of the pitch (fairground only) will be granted if the registration form is returned by the 1 March 2008 AND payment of the invoice for the deposit and the invoice for the balance is sent within 10 days following the dispatch of these invoices. A credit note will be sent to you if both of these conditions are met and we will refund the amount of the discount after the fair.

Reservation of a stand, whether this is done by post, fax, or via the Internet, shall only take effect when the deposit of 50% of the hire charge and all the fixed costs* have been paid within thirty days of the file having been dispatched. After this period, the organising committee reserves the right to regard the reservation as cancelled. However, by sending the subscription form to the organising committee, be this by post, fax or via the Internet, the subscriber submits to the regulations governing the fair and is still liable for cancellation charges as stipulated in Article 7bis of said regulations.

ONLY THE OFFICIAL, WRITTEN CONFIRMATION AND THE DATED SITE PLAN WILL 3

CERTIFY THE AVAILABILITY AND ACTUAL RESERVATION OF THE STAND (NUMBER AND SURFACE AREA) *FIXED COSTS: €302.00 excluding VAT - €342.00 excluding VAT for stands in the Ardenne Joyeuse, Market Hall and Village du Cheval areas).

The Organising Committee reserves the right to increase the stand hire fee by 25% for all RESERVATION applications or MODIFICATIONS that arrive after 1 July.

ADMISSIBLE EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS (Fairground)

ART. 3 BIS

The display of agricultural equipment is only open to machinery and products relating to agriculture, horticulture and forestry as well as civil engineering. In the "Market Hall" priority will be given to companies which sell foodstuffs.

Only the products and brands mentioned on the entry application forms (Document 3: directory data), and which comply with the provisions of the present Regulations may be exhibited and included in the catalogue. Only exhibitors who are officially delegated by the constructor of the equipment or product are allowed to participate. Exhibitors may only exhibit on their stand **new equipment from the official distribution network**. Exhibiting reconditioned or second-hand equipment in real or documentary form is strictly forbidden. All exhibited equipment shall comply with the laws and regulations applicable in the country of destination.

Penalties: each exhibitor explicitly acknowledges that the Organising Committee is entitled to remove any exhibited product that does not comply with the stipulations of the present Regulations, at the cost and risk of the former. The Organising Committee is entitled to sanction any exhibitor infringing the provisions of the present Regulations, with a fine, fixed by court at €620.00 excluding VAT per infringement, without prejudice to any resulting damage claim that might exceed this amount.

REGISTRATION

ART. 4

In order to participate in the fair and/or in the forestry demonstrations, exhibitors must complete a participation form (form 1 and/or 2 and/or 3) which is sent to all former exhibitors as a matter of course or which can be requested from the S.R. Le Cheval de Trait Ardennais, rue des Aubépines in B-6800 Libramont. An amount of €70.00 to cover administration costs will be charged for every application for participation. The Society retains this amount even if the application is not accepted. Exhibitors from 2007 are given priority if they return the form **BY 1 MARCH 2008**, unless an imperative linked to the general organisation or a modification of the infrastructure makes this impossible.

After this date, the organisers are free to allocate the pitches as they wish. The return of this form is necessary for the reservation of a pitch. It is not possible to reserve a pitch by telephone. Applications received **AFTER 1 MARCH 2008** will only be considered in the chronological order in which they were received by the secretariat.

Should it appear after 1 March 2008 that there is not enough exhibition space, the Committee may impose an order of priority, so as to accept only one exhibitor for each product range of a particular brand. In such cases, priority shall be as follows:

1. manufacturer
2. importer or distributor designated by the manufacturer
3. in the absence of such designation, the first exhibitor registered, in accordance with the conditions laid down in Article 3bis.

Reservation of a stand, whether this is done by post, fax, or via the Internet, shall only take effect when the deposit of 50% of the hire charge and all the fixed costs have been paid within thirty days of the file having been dispatched. After this period, the organising committee reserves the right to regard the reservation as cancelled. However, by sending the subscription form to the organising committee, be this by post, fax or via the Internet, the subscriber submits to the regulations governing the fair and is still liable for cancellation charges as stipulated in Article 7bis of said regulations

Exhibitors installed on the edge of event rings (Grand Ring, Genitec, Competition Rings, 4 x 4 Ring, etc.) accept the sound events related to the activities that take place in these areas.

Exhibitors who apply for a stand on the ground floor of **Walexpo** (thematic exhibition) must work in a line of business or offer a service in keeping with the theme of the year. A document describing the themes used in Walexpo can be downloaded from www.foiredelibramont.com in the section THEME AND NEW FEATURES. For reasons of consistency of the thematic exhibition, these stands are erected by an exclusive stand manufacturer whose contact details are given in the WALEXPO 1B registration document. Acceptance of exhibitor applications for Walexpo will be made by the organising committee on the basis of the line of business described in document 3 (directory data) and subject to the availability of spaces.

There are three categories of stand on the ground floor of Walexpo:

The price for hiring the floor area will be invoiced by Libramont Fair (SR Le Cheval de Trait Ardennais). The price for fitting out will be invoiced directly by the stand manufacturer.

Stands A,B,C are provided on a **turnkey** basis (partition, carpet, lighting, furniture, water and electricity connections included) according to the briefing received from the exhibitor. Special technology (sound, ventilation, etc.) is not included in the price.

In addition, the price includes digital printing (file to be sent by exhibitor) as follows

STAND A	1m ² of digiprint for 8 m ² of stand
STAND B	1m ² of digiprint for 15 m ² of stand
STAND C	1m ² of digiprint for 25 m ² of stand

Exhibitors who apply for a stand on the mezzanine (upstairs) of Walexpo must work in a line of business or offer a service of general, educational or media interest.

These stands are supplied equipped with partitions, carpet, lighting, and exhibitor identification pediment at a price of €50/m², including €25/m² for hire of the floor area which will be invoiced by Libramont Fair (SR Le Cheval de Trait Ardennais) and €25/m² for fitting out the stand which will be invoiced by the stand manufacturer. Services such as electrical, water and/or phone connection are additional and must be ordered using the appropriate order forms.

Moreover, the Committee reserves the right to refuse such and such an application without having to justify its decision to the applicant. The return of an entry form or the receipt of a deposit form does not under any circumstances mean that a reservation has been made. The Organising Committee will send the exhibitor written confirmation of the pitch reservation (size and number).

The Committee reserves the right to increase the stand hire fee by 25% for all reservation applications or modifications that arrive after 1 July.

ART. 5

Admission as an exhibitor is nominative, non-transferable and inalienable and exhibitors may not under any circumstances assign, sublet, lend or transfer free of charge or in return for a consideration all or part of their pitch except with the prior written agreement of the Committee. Any infringement of this provision will result in the subscriber having to pay the Committee a penalty which is equivalent to twice the full cost of hiring the stand. In the same way, the Committee can also decide to close the stand immediately. **If several firms are represented on a same pitch, each one of them will pay the fixed and compulsory costs and fill out form no. 3 "technical data". Indirect exhibitors must be mentioned on the exhibitor's subscription form (form 1 and/or 2 and/or 3).** It is prohibited to exhibit equipment or products other than those mentioned in the registration form entitled "Technical Data", which is the document on which the insurance and catalogue are based.

ART. 5 BIS

Once you have registered, you will be able to download the fair vade-mecum from the official fair site (www.foiredelibramont.com) from 1 March 2008. If you do not have an Internet connection, we will send the vade-mecum out to the exhibitor by post on request only. This sets out all the technical restrictions and possibilities related to participating in the Libramont Fair.

PAYMENT FOR PITCHES

ART. 6

Half of the hire charge is payable upon subscription (invoice for the deposit) and the other half upon receipt of the invoice for the balance, that is during the first half of July and, at any rate, BEFORE the 20th of this month at the latest. Any application which arrives after 1 June 2008 is payable in full upon subscription.

The applicant will pay the registration fee (Art. 4), the Insurance premium (Art. 18), the charge for the exhibitor's directory (Art. 10) and the fixed charge for maintenance of the showground (Art. 21) at the same time as the deposit (Art. 10).

The invoices are payable in cash. The non-payment of an invoice on the due date entitles the organisers to demand the payment of any other outstanding amounts and to cancel any pitch by registered letter. In the 5

b. Proper use of grassy areas and lawns

Driving or walking off the roads is prohibited, as is parking or turning on the grassy areas. The penalty is €750.00, exclusive of VAT.

c. Setting up of tents and marquees

The hired pitch should be larger than the marquee by 1 metre in both length and depth.

Booth water drain plates must be kept clear.

DURATION OF THE EXHIBITION

ART. 9

The exhibition will be open from Friday 25 to Monday 28 July 2007, between 9.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. Entrance doors will be closed to the public from 6.30 p.m. In the registration form, exhibitors undertake to attend for four days, to have their stand set up by the Thursday evening, and not to take it down or remove their equipment before 7.00 p.m. on Monday 28 July. Any company which does not comply with this provision will not be allowed to participate in future fairs. Special demonstration days can be organised both inside and outside the Fair enclosure with a view to promoting particular types of equipment.

LAYOUT, DIRECTORY OF EXHIBITORS AND PROGRAMME OF THE FAIR

ART. 10

The exhibitor's directory and the official programme are the official advertising organs for the event. The official directory of the Fair of Libramont is made available to visitors free of charge. It contains all information (in 4 languages) relating to the exhibitors: an alphabetic list of exhibiting companies and a list of the equipment and products exhibited. These lists will be produced in French, Dutch, German and English. Careful editorial advertising on the topics of agricultural and forestry popularisation will supplement this information and make up the programme. The programme is a 24-page document printed on newsprint, which is inserted in the newspapers published by Editions de l'Avenir and distributed throughout Wallonia a few days before the start of the event. The Dutch version is inserted in one or more dailies. The programme, as well as the layout of the Fair, are also available free to visitors, either in paper version at the Fair site itself, or as a download from the Internet site www.foiredelibramont.com.

Each exhibitor will be charged €95.00 for these two publications regardless of the type of equipment or products exhibited and the area occupied. Exhibitors are requested to fill in Form 3 in the registration file. This document, which concerns the description of the exhibitor's activity, is compulsory. It is used as a basis for the allocation of pitches in the appropriate area, as well as for the publication of data in the exhibitors' directory. If this form is not returned by the deadline (1 March 2008) and the exhibitor is not included in the list of exhibitors (paper director and Internet site), exhibitors will not be able to claim damages. Exhibitors who submit their application for subscription outside the period required for the printing of this official catalogue will also be liable to pay this amount. All exhibitors have the opportunity of placing an advertisement in the official directory or in the Fair programme (Form 3).

EXHIBITION COMMITTEE

A. General policy

ART. 11

Exhibitors must, under penalty of exclusion, comply with the conditions imposed by public laws and regulations and particularly the requirements relating to hygiene, safety, fire protection, staff occupation, the labelling of prices, fair practice and matters of advertising and customs and excise.

Members of the Committee and public bodies have the right to gain access to the pitch of the exhibitor at any time in order to satisfy themselves that the requirements relating to the above as well as those contained in these regulations are being met.

The management can ensure that any change which it regards as appropriate is implemented at the expense of the exhibitor.

Checks, controls or changes made as a result of the intervention of the Committee in no way imply that it is liable.

ART. 11 Bis

A special steward will be given full authority to ensure that the exhibition is organised as well as possible. The steward will, among other things, ensure that the equipment exhibited on the stand is NEW and complies in full with the information on Document 3. He will be authorised to remove non-compliant equipment at the expense and risk of the non-compliant exhibitor. He will be available at all times to answer any questions that exhibitors might have regarding the exhibition, and will be found at the General Secretariat (Walexpo). He will be assisted in his mission by deputy stewards. As a general rule, exhibitors are not allowed to demonstrate the operation of any motors and equipment, or use a microphone to address the public. All companies which supply agricultural and/or forestry equipment will be allowed to perform demonstrations during the Fair subject to the prior agreement of the Organising Committee.

In the Market Hall, the use of a public address system to address visitors with the aid of a microphone is completely prohibited. The steward responsible for the Hall, who will be authorised to enforce this provision, may, if necessary, deprive any exhibitor who does not obey his orders of his connection to the electricity supply.

A steward will be given full authority to ensure that the demonstrations in the GENITEC area are as orderly as possible.

Furthermore, any structure visible at height installed on the stand, whether it be a "tower", balloon or any other structure with a height of 4 metres or more, is subject to approval by the Organising Committee and to checks by the company AIB. Such structures will incur a charge of €500 excl. VAT (not including the costs of approval by an approved body, AIB) – see also Article 16.

B. Service cards

ART. 12

1. Free service cards

- a. Fairground: Free service cards will be issued to provide permanent entry to members of staff belonging to the exhibiting companies on the fairground. The number of cards issued will depend on the size of the pitch as follows:

4 m of frontage:	2 free service cards
5 to 10 m of frontage:	4 free service cards
11 to 20 m of frontage:	6 free service cards
21 to 40 m of frontage:	8 free service cards
41 m and more of frontage:	10 free service cards

2. Additional permanent service cards.

- a. LIBRAMONT FAIRGROUND: €2.00 excl. VAT per card (**reserved for staff on the stand**). To be valid, the service cards must bear the name of the company to which they have been given. They will be sent straight to the person in charge in a sealed and stamped envelope a few days before the Fair following the receipt of the payment. No copies will be provided. Exhibitors should then supply one to each member of their staff. **After 10 June 2008, the cards will cost €18.00, excluding VAT. From 10 July, this price will rise to €25.00 excl. VAT.**

3. Customers' admission tickets:

- a. LIBRAMONT FAIRGROUND: a limited number of customers' admission tickets (maximum of 1,000 tickets) can be obtained at a reduced price of €6.00 excluding VAT (tickets only grant entry once on one of the four days), until 10 June. **After 10 June, the full price of €11.00 excluding VAT will be charged, and from 10 July this will rise to €13.00 excluding VAT.**

- b. Customers (= professionals from the agricultural and forestry sector) resident abroad: exhibitors can obtain free invitations for their foreign customers. Customers in possession of this invitation are asked to present themselves at the International Club, which is for their exclusive use and which is located at the Walexpo Gate and/or Market Hall Gate. They will be asked to show a professional card (business card, etc.).

4. All the cards can only be ordered using the appropriate form (Form 4), either by post or fax or via the Internet site www.foiredelibrumont.com (exhibiting - (registration) - services). The payment or transfer must be made to account CREDIT AGRICOLE 103-3234796-11 of the Société Royale "Le Cheval de Trait Ardennais" in Libramont (IBAN : BE 30 1033 2347 9611 - BIC : NICA BEBB), giving details of the type and number of cards required (**up to 10 June at the latest**). **After this date, no customer cards will be issued at the previously quoted price.**

5. N.B.: All "CUSTOMER" cards issued after 10 June will be invoiced at the full price. "SERVICE" or "CUSTOMER" cards may not be sold by the exhibitors **under any circumstances.**

C. ACCOMMODATION ON THE STANDS (OUTSIDE ONLY)

ART. 13

After having previously requested it in writing, only exhibitors having animals on show and who have a special permit which has been issued by the secretariat of the Society and who have a caravan which is specially equipped for night stays will be able to stay on site.

D. Access for cars and other vehicles

ART. 14

1. PARKING

A. Fairground:

The Organising Committee will make three special car parks ("Exhibitors" car parks) available to exhibitors at a price of €6.00, excluding VAT, per vehicle. **From 10 June onwards, the cost will be €10, excluding VAT, and from 10 July this will rise to €12, excluding VAT.**

1. Outside stand car park at entrance "Porte des Concours" and "Porte de l'Esplanade"
2. Market Hall car park at entrance "Porte de la ville"

Park and ride facilities will be arranged at junctions 26 and 25 bis of the E411 motorway. A free shuttle service will be provided for the 4 days of the event.

2. PARKING VEHICLES ON THE STAND

For reasons of security relating to people and possessions, the Committee has decided that **only a very limited** number of permits will be issued for parking vehicles on stands. Very strict regulations define the conditions (see vade-mecum).

3. STOCKING THE STAND

A permit for stocking the stand before 9.00 a.m. must be requested in advance (special access for service vehicles between 8.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. only). Very strict regulations define the conditions (see vade-mecum). A free shuttle service will be organised for the exhibitors between the exhibitor car parks and the stands.

ELECTRICITY

ART. 15

In the fairground, electricity will be supplied to exhibitors **who have expressly requested it by 1 June at the latest**. An alternating current will be supplied: 400 volts three-phase or 230 volts single-phase. The Committee reserves the right to disconnect the current for a short while. Exhibitors are allowed to bring their own electrical connections. These must comply with safety standards.

For safety reasons, pirate connections are formally prohibited. Any exhibitor who is a party to them will be deprived of the required connection to the electricity supply.

For outside stands in the exhibition ground, the safety box must contain a 30 MA or maximum 100 MA differential, adequate protection for each circuit, an earth connection, a flexible cable of the CTLB or CTMB type or a vinyl cable of the VTMB type. It will be of sufficient length for connection to the existing transmission network.

In order to ensure that the connection to the power supply is effected properly, every exhibitor who has finished his installation is required to report to the ELECTRICITY office situated next to the Conference Centre (30/01) for the purpose of having the installation checked and connected to the power supply.

In the case of the stands situated in the Market Hall, Walexpo and marquee of the organiser, the necessary equipment is limited to a connection box containing at least one socket. The payment of a fixed amount is charged in a separate invoice including connection and consumption.

The connections are only made following the acceptance of the installations by an authorised body.

It will not be possible to claim any damages from the Committee in the case of breakdown and/or power failure.

For any further information and to order electrical supply, please refer to the "Electricity form" (Form 7) in the registration file.

LIABILITY & INSURANCE

ART. 16

The exhibitors install, manage and conduct their stands at their own risk and subject to their own liability. They take all useful measures with regard to this. In the event of a shortcoming on the part of the exhibitor, the Committee may, at the expense of the exhibitor and without prior formal notice, take all protective measures necessary, either in the exhibition area or on the forestry demonstration site.

For buildings and other upright structures with a height in excess of 4 metres (advertising towers, stands, etc.), exhibitors are obliged to request an AIB VINCOTTE agent to check the structure. When this agent comes to carry out his inspection, the exhibitor or his subcontractor should present the construction plans for the structure to him. The certificate of conformity issued by AIB VINCOTTE will be forwarded to the Fair secretariat as quickly as possible.

If this certificate is not received 12 hours before the Fair opens, and once the exhibitor has been informed, the Exhibition Park Commissioner may take the initiative to call in an AIB VINCOTTE agent. The costs inherent in approving or ensuring the conformity of these upright structures are borne by the exhibitor. Structures which do not comply will be dismantled.

Furthermore, installation of such a structure, whether it be a "tower", balloon or any other structure, is subject to approval by the Organising Committee and will incur a charge of €500 excl. VAT (not including the costs of approval by an approved body, AIB) – see also Article 11bis.

INSURANCE

ART. 17

The exhibitors are required to insure the civil liability arising from their participation in the Fair via their own insurance company for matters of civil liability relating to business or agricultural concerns.

At the request of the exhibitors, the Organising Committee has nevertheless taken out a group policy for civil liability for accidental damage caused to third parties during the Fair and at the time of setting up and removing the installations, excluding damage caused by motorised vehicles which are covered by the Law of 21/11/89.

The insurance provides cover for a maximum of €1,239,468 in the case of bodily injury and €123,947 in the case of material damage per contingency insured against, with a 25 € excess on damage to property (this amount being charged to the exhibitor).

The Organising Committee of the Fair has also taken out an "All-Risks" type of insurance policy subject to the conditions defined in it (fire, lightning, explosion, theft, vandalism, water damage or destruction resulting from an accident).

This property is covered for an amount of €12,395 for the first risk, with a €124 excess per contingency insured against (this amount being charged to the exhibitor).

The exhibitors undertake to insure all property exhibited (the merchandise, the stand and the equipment).

If expressly requested, a higher amount can be insured upon the payment of an additional premium.

TERMS OF INSURANCE

ART. 18

This group insurance is compulsory for all exhibitors. The group premium is set at €75 per stand. This provides Civil Liability and all-risks insurance. These amounts include taxes and charges.

The exhibitor completes the insurance proposal supplied and the Organising Committee gives him a certified true copy of it.

The premium is paid in full at the same time as the deposit for the registration for the Fair. No confirmation of participation will be sent prior to the receipt of these two amounts.

DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT OF THE INSURANCE

ART. 19

The period of cover extends from midnight on the Wednesday before the Fair, 23 July 2008, to midnight on the Tuesday following the Fair, 29 July 2008, for equipment exhibited on the site. The insurance only takes effect once the exhibitor has duly submitted to the Exhibition Committee a detailed inventory of the items covered and their value, which must be done by 6.00 p.m. on 15 June.

In the event of theft or acts of malicious intent, the exhibitor is obliged to inform the Federal Police immediately (Tel. +32(0)61 508 130), followed by the organising committee (+ 32 (0)61 230 404) and then to send the statement of claim to the broker by fax (+32 (0)61 224 546) the same day.

As regards other dangers (civil liability - all risks), if an incident occurs, the exhibitor must inform the organising committee and then immediately make a statement at the broker's office.

RENUNCIATION & RECOURSE

ART. 20

The Organising Committee of the Fair disclaims any liability for accidents, theft or damage which might arise. By signing the membership form, the exhibitor completely releases the Organising Committee from any liability and expressly renounces any right of recourse which he might be entitled to exercise against both the organiser and, should the case arise, the owner of the marquee for damage caused to equipment and items belonging to him.

Each participant is asked to ensure that all “small equipment”, such as tools, machines and various objects that are easy to take away, are stored safely. If the site stewards observe that this is not the case, the insurance company may reserve the right not to insure the exhibitor concerned.

ART. 20 BIS

The exhibitor acknowledges that he has been made aware of the terms of the insurance policy which he is taking out by the Secretariat of the Fair.

ART. 21

SITE MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

The maintenance and cleanliness of the Trade Fair (including the official car parks) are a major concern for all. A professional cleaning service (including the processing of sorted waste) will be available to the exhibitors. Bin bags will be distributed before and during the trade fair by the cleaning team. Sorted waste removal will be performed each evening during the installation week. Two mini container parks will be available to the exhibitors. During the Trade Fair, waste must be left in bin bags **each evening** in front of the stand by the exhibitors, and will be removed by the cleaning service. Exhibitors and their subcontractors are expressly required to comply with this provision. Carpets will be removed by the stand holders or those hiring tents. If this is not done, exhibitors will be charged for the cost of their removal. **Further information is provided in the vade-mecum given to exhibitors at the time of registration.**

A fixed flat rate of €62 (excluding VAT) per exhibitor will be charged in order to meet the considerable challenge of keeping the Trade Fair clean. In view of the large quantity of waste generated, this fee will be increased to €102 excluding VAT for exhibitors selling foodstuffs or any other product directly to the public. The exhibitors concerned will be allocated space in “Ardenne Joyeuse”, Market Hall and Horse Village. This mandatory flat rate for maintenance does not cover cleaning of the stand itself. Exhibitors requiring a daily cleaning service for their stand can obtain this subject to payment of an additional flat rate by returning the order form founding the vade-mecum and on the Internet site www.foiredelibramont.com (exhibiting - (registration) - services).

ART. 22

SAFETY DEVICE

In order to reinforce security for all exhibitors and visitors, all security services will be coordinated and supervised. All exhibitors are asked to abide by the regulations detailed by the safety department in the exhibitor’s information file (the exhibitor’s information file will be sent immediately after receipt of the application form).

The use of barbecues and gas units on stands is strictly forbidden, except in the catering areas and with the consent of the regional fire service.

VARIOUS PROVISIONS

ART. 23

Every day, the exhibition ground is closed and will have to be cleared by 7.00 p.m. In the case of people staying on their stand, please consult Article 13. The security service appointed by the Organising Committee during the night from 7.00 p.m. to 8.00 a.m. from SATURDAY 19 to WEDNESDAY 30 July is a precautionary measure which does not in any way imply the liability of the Committee, as stated in Article 20.

ART. 24

The Committee will open the Fair at 10:00 a.m. on FRIDAY 25 July. The exhibitors are asked to be at their stands.

ART. 25

Any questions and disputes which might arise during the Fair and which are not provided for in this programme fall within the competence of the Committee, the only judge in the matter. Any problems must be immediately reported to the Committee at the reception on the fairground.

ART. 26

Access to the fair ground will only be allowed to street vendors subject to the approval of the Organising Committee. They will in any case have to produce any documents which show that they are travelling salesmen.

ART. 26 BIS

These regulations prohibit any canvassing and any collection along the paths, at the entries and on the car parks of the Fair, except where express and written dispensation is granted by the Committee. Similarly, no tracts may be distributed at these places. The use of sandwich men and other such advertising devices is strictly forbidden off the stands.

ART. 27

It is prohibited to sell or offer for retail sale any products, drinks or consumable provisions on site without the express authorisation of the Committee. This authorisation will be accompanied by an invoice for a special amount. Free tasting and the distribution of samples are, however, permitted.

The free distribution of drinks is subject to the prior agreement of the Organising Committee which will confine itself to recording the fact without assuming liability.

In the same way, exhibitors are prohibited from offering small animals for sale or in the tombola.

ART. 28

The Organising Committee will not under any circumstances be liable if the event has to be adjourned, cancelled or closed early as the result of an accident or an act of God. War, illness, riots, strikes, demonstrations, fires, explosions and any circumstance which is beyond the control of the organisers are primarily regarded as acts of God.

In this case, exhibitors who have received confirmation of their reservation will not be able to claim any compensation but only the repayment of sums paid less organisation costs incurred by the Committee and this in proportion to their participation.

ART. 29

No digger whatsoever may be used on the stands. However, civil engineering machinery may be displayed in the "GENITEC" permanent demonstration ring. Access to the narrated demonstration shall be invoiced at €250.00 per piece of equipment excl. VAT and shall be subject to specific rules (see vade-mecum). Each company that registers for these organised demonstrations shall also be given the opportunity to book an individual demonstration area (for specific rules see vade-mecum), invoiced at €50.00 before VAT.

A demonstration area is reserved for 4 x 4 vehicles and quad bikes. This area is accessible only by registering with the firms renting a pitch at the fair or who are connected to the Organising Committee by a partnership agreement. The cost of participation is a flat fee of €300 excl. VAT per vehicle. A steward appointed by the Organising Committee will coordinate demonstrations, including supervising access to the track.

ART. 30

Dogs or other pets must be kept on a leash.

ART. 31

The exhibitor formally undertakes to comply with all the clauses of **these regulations and the vade-mecum**, which shall be strictly applied and may not be considered comminatory.

The courts of NEUFCHATEAU have exclusive jurisdiction to hear any dispute which may arise.

Disputes relating to the interpretation of provisions of the regulations and specific guidelines governing the organisation of the fair shall be ruled upon by the Committee.

By virtue of their membership alone and throughout the period of the Libramont Agricultural, Forestry and Agri-Foodstuffs Fair and the periods of installation and removal, the exhibitors, for the purposes of their participation, expressly elect special domicile at their stand, where all notifications may consequently validly be sent.

I. OUTSIDE PITCHES - from 25 to 28 July

These are allocated according to availability and only in the areas specially provided for the branch of activity in question.

A. Agricultural, forestry and civil engineering equipment, horticultural equipment and agricultural products – see form 1A

Pitches covering an area of 150 m² or less: €10.40/m²

Pitches covering an area of 151 m² to 400 m²: €9.40/m²

Pitches covering an area of 401 m² to 500 m²: €8.40/m²

Pitches covering an area of more than 500 m²: €7.40/m²

Pitches with several floors: surcharge of 50%

Pitches bordering on a ring: surcharge of €1/m²

Each fraction of a square metre will be charged as one square metre.

Surcharge for corner location: €20.00 per corner

Minimum hire charge: €374.40

Each fraction of a square metre will be charged as one square metre.

The stand hire costs will be increased by 25% for any stand reservations or modifications which arrive after 1 July.

IV. HIRE CHARGE

Reservation of a stand, whether this is done by post, fax, or via the Internet, shall only take effect when the deposit of 50% of the hire charge and all the fixed costs* have been paid within thirty days of the file having been dispatched. After this period, the organising committee reserves the right to regard the reservation as cancelled. However, by sending the subscription form to the organising committee, be this by post, fax or via the Internet, the subscriber submits to the regulations governing the fair and is still liable for cancellation charges as stipulated in Article 7bis of said regulations. (* €302 excl. VAT and €342 excl. VAT for exhibitors in the Ardenne Joyeuse, Market Hall and Village du Cheval areas – see form 1).

A discount of 10% of the price of the pitch (on the fairground) will be granted if the registration form is returned by 1 March 2008 **AND** payment of the invoice for the deposit and the invoice for the balance is sent within 10 days of the dispatch of the invoices. A credit note will be sent to you if these two conditions are met and we will return the amount of the discount after the fair.

ONLY THE OFFICIAL WRITTEN CONFIRMATION WILL CERTIFY THE ACTUAL RESERVATION AND AVAILABILITY OF THE STAND.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to increase the pitch hire rate by 25% for any pitch reservations or modifications which reach us after 1 July.
